Book prices range from \$5 to \$40 and there is a great variety to suit everyone's taste.

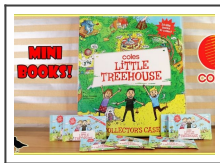
Cash and Eftpos payments are accepted.

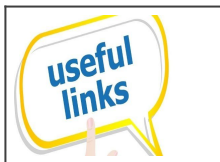
A commission on all purchases made earns books for our school Library.
