We have successfully applied for a grant to replace our Early Childhood shades. The successful \$20 000 grant and some school funds will be used to replace our aging EC shade structures.

The new structure will consist of a colorbond roof that will span the whole length of the Centre 1 and Centre 2 classrooms. This will provide an all-weather area to eat lunch and conduct outdoor learning, even on rainy days. This will be a great addition to our Early Childhood area.
